

Examination for the Research Project

- ✓ The research project shall be assessed in accordance with the common regulations of the Board of Postgraduate Studies of the University of Nairobi.
- ✓ A project is equivalent to four (4) units.
- ✓ The project shall be not less than 20,000 word document on an issue of interest which is relevant to the area of specialization that the candidate has studied.
- ✓ A candidate shall be required to be supervised and to submit a research project report for examination to the department at least two (2) weeks before end of the semester in which the work is to be examined.
- ✓ The project report shall be marked out of 100% and the pass mark for the project shall be 50%.
- ✓ A candidate who fails to satisfy examiners in the research project may on the recommendation of the School Board of Examiners and approval by Senate be allowed to re-submit the project for examination up-to two times within the stipulated maximum period allowed for the course.
- ✓ A candidate who fails after the second re-submission of a project may on the recommendation of the School Board of Examiners and approval of Senate be discontinued.
- ✓ A candidate who fails to complete the programme of study within a period of twelve semesters (six academic years) shall on the recommendation of the School Board of Examiners and approval of Senate be discontinued.
